The Board of Ellis County Commissioner met in Special Session at 5:00 p.m., Thursday, April 16, 2020, to canvass the results of April 7, 2020, Countywide Sales Tax Mail Ballot Election.

Chair Robert "Butch" Schlyer called the special meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Commissioners present: Chair Robert "Butch" Schlyer, Dustin G. Roths and Dean F. Haselhorst.

Also present were County Clerk/Election Officer Donna J. Maskus.

CANVASS OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION OF APRIL 7, 2020 COUNTYWIDE SALES TAX MAIL BALLOT ELECTION

County Clerk/Election Officer Maskus presented the results of the April 7, 2020 Countywide Sales Tax Election.

The Canvass Board was Commissioners Schlyer, Roths and Haselhorst.

Maskus reported a 42% (forty-two percent) voter turnout with 16,709 ballots mailed out. There were 1169 ballots returned that were undeliverable because a change of residence and/or name since ballots are sent to the voter's registered address. She encouraged voters to contact her office if they did not receive a ballot to make sure they are currently registered to vote for the upcoming 2020 Primary and General Elections.

Proposition #2:	Yes-3886	No-2630
