The Board of Ellis County Commissioners met in special session for a Road Tour at 1:30 p.m., Monday, April 29, 2019, Hays, Kansas.

Chair Dean F. Haselhorst called the meeting to order at 1:33 p.m. at the County Shop, 1195 280<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Hays, Kansas.

Commissioners present: Chair Dean F. Haselhorst and Commissioner Robert “Butch” Schlyer were present. Commissioner Dustin G. Roths joined the meeting at 1:36 p.m.

Also present were County Administrator Phillip Smith-Hanes, Public Works Director Bill Ring, Road Supervisor Curt Hoffman, Road Foreman Dave Hoffman, Architect Ben Moore and Jonathan Zweygardt of Eagle Communications.

The meeting began with a review of possible plans for a new Public Work’s shop. Architect Ben Moore presented concept drawings and answered questions.

At 2:17 p.m. the discussion of plans concluded, and Architect Moore departed. Public Works Director Ring provided those in attendance with an overview of Public Works services. Safety vests were distributed, and everyone got into a rented van. The group departed the yard at 2:25 p.m.

Sites visited included: The L. Kuhn 4<sup>th</sup> Addition, a stone arch bridge on Toulon Road, Cathedral Avenue in Victoria, Bridge 300 on Catharine Road, tree line and sight issues along Catharine Road in Catherine, a property with materials encroaching onto the right-of-way, the Deer Creek and Little Creek Estates Subdivisions and Feedlot Road. A cost estimate for various paving options on Feedlot Road was presented. The group returned to the yard and Director Ring asked Commissioners for direction on future equipment purchases.
